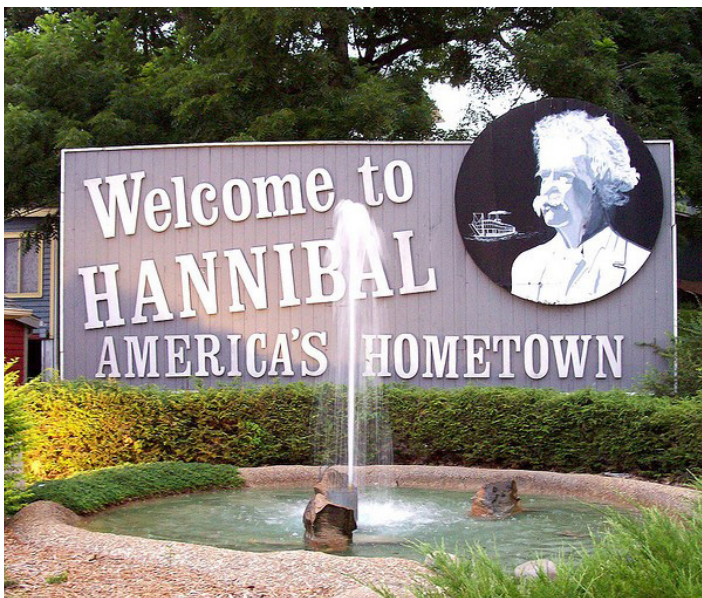

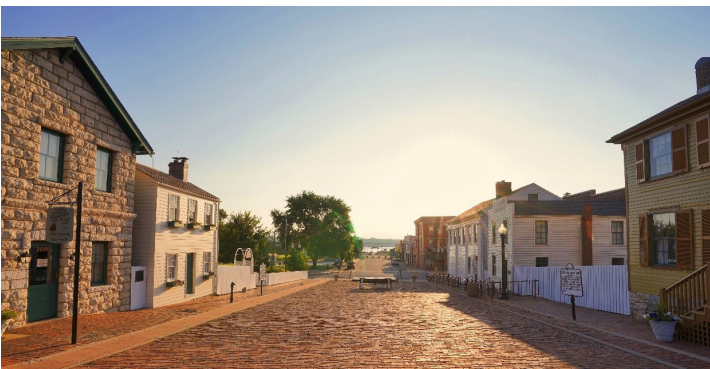
Mark Twain Cave and Cameron Cave

Mark Twain Cave is Missouri's first show cave. The first organized guided tour was in 1886. We proudly became a National Natural Landmark in 1972.

Mark Twain Boyhood Home & Museum
